LOTTERY - Next budget year the Lottery prize money will be raised to £1 million and will feature a £20,000 first prize, a £10,000 second prize and a total of 150 prizes each month. Additionally, there will be a special 90th Anniversary draw - details to be announced soon. You need to be in it to win it - the number of new members continues to rise significantly.

MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTIONS - there will be no increase in the cost of subs in 2025. **DEVELOPMENT FUND** decisions - will move from the Awards Committee to the National HASSRA team (see below for further details).

CASH BACK SCHEMES - the regional Board will be exploring possibilities where cash back incentives may be available.

90th CELEBRATIONS - the national Board has approved a number of ideas for celebrating this significant milestone in HASSRA's history and the Central Team is now working up details before releasing the information to the regions.

have heard already that next year the Lottery prize fund is getting bigger again, with each month a £20,000 first prize, 2 x £10,000 second prizes and 150 prizes in all. But how does it work? Each month a random number machine on the lines of ERNIE (the Premium Bond

machine) is operated by two independent adjudicators. Every Lottery subscriber who has paid up by the end of the previous month is entered into that month's draw. The draw takes place on the last day of the month or one or two days either side depending on all payroll details having been received. And don't worry -all winners are notified direct so if you've won, you'll know! The number of members buying Lottery tickets is forever increasing so if you're not in

already, do something about it! * TASTER DAY - Curling at the Bayswater Ice Rink - What a great
